Position Overview

The mission of the Sheila C. "Skip" Nowell Leadership Academy is to ensure that Rhode Island's pregnant, parenting and underserved youth graduate from high school with the knowledge and skills they need to be prepared for success in college, career and family life.

The Nowell Leadership Academy seeks a passionate and highly skilled **Nurse Practitioner** willing to provide exceptional reproductive health counseling support to the pregnant and parenting students of the Nowell Leadership Academy. The Nurse Practitioner provides weekly, on-site reproductive health counseling. This position reports to the School Nurse Teacher and Director of Wrap-around Supports. This is an hourly, contracted position for the 2019-2020 academic school year.

Specific Duties & Responsibilities include:

- Prescribing and administering various types of birth control, including IUDs, the birth control "pill," contraceptive patches and the dep provera "shot"
- Conducting confidential screening for sexually transmitted infections
- Providing confidential reproductive health counseling to students and communicating with Nowell Leadership Academy faculty and staff

Qualifications:

- Active Rhode Island state licensure with a preference for certification as a women's health nurse practitioner, family nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwifery
- Five years experience as a certified Nurse Practitioner, including a minimum of two years experience working with adolescent parents
- Spanish language fluency highly preferred
